

Website Privacy Policy



Introduction

Your privacy concerns are important to Wise County Youth Soccer Association. You need to know what information about you is being collected over the Internet and how that information is being used. Wise County Youth Soccer Association and its website, www.wisecountyyouthsoccer.org are committed to assisting you in this regard. To that end, this policy explains what information is collected by WCYSA from users of the Site and how that information may be used by WCYSA.

Other Websites

The website may be linked to other websites. While this policy describes privacy issues relating to the Site, it does not describe the practices of any web site that may be linked to the website. You should consult the privacy policies of those other websites before submitting any information to them. Wise County Youth Soccer Association is only responsible for information collected by it through the Site.

Collection of Information

Most of the information collected by WCYSA is provided directly by you. When using the website, you may be asked to provide information about yourself, such as your name and e-mail address. If you do not want WCYSA to have that information, you should not provide it. However, you may not be able to then enjoy some of the website's benefits.

Use of Information

WCYSA only collects information for the purpose of making the website more useful to its users or otherwise to better serve its users. Information collected by WCYSA may also be used to occasionally notify you about changes to the website, services offered by WCYSA, recent developments at WCYSA, and offers you may find of interest. Statistics may also be compiled by WCYSA for many purposes using information provided by you. However, all statistics will be aggregated with other users of the website and will not be associated with an individual user.

Cookies

Like many websites, wisecountyyouthsoccer.org may use "cookies." Cookies are small pieces of information that are stored by your web browser on your

computer's hard drive. They enable the website to recognize you as a repeat user of the website. Your web browser may provide you with the ability to not accept "cookies." However, in order to take full advantage of the website, WCYSA recommends that you accept "cookies" from the website.

Security

When you use the website, WCYSA uses tools (such as firewalls) to safeguard your information from unauthorized access.

Minors

If you are under 18, WCYSA recommends you use the website with the supervision of a parent or guardian.

Disclosure

WCYSA does not sell or otherwise disclose your personal information to others without your authorization, except that WCYSA may disclose such information to any successor of WCYSA or when it believes, in good faith, that such disclosure is reasonably necessary to comply with any law or protect the rights, property or safety of another person.

Consent

By using the website, you consent to the collection and use of information by WCYSA as set forth in this policy.

Changes

WCYSA may change this policy at any time without notice to you. If WCYSA change this policy, it will post those changes on this page. By continuing to use the website after any such change is posted, you agree to such change. You should periodically check the website for changes to this policy.
